We also have an OASYS training course going for 6 weeks, OASYS stands for open-source aquaponic system. This is our smaller system that we get to take and build all over the world in other places, making it an amazing tool for evangelism. I am getting to participate in this course to learn more in-depth how to build, manage and maintain our system to keep it working. During the course, we will be building a whole new system, getting it up and running to then be able to experiment with what it

takes to grow other produce like tomatoes, peppers, herbs, and maybe even potatoes. We want to be able to produce enough food for people who are using these systems to get as much nutrients and variety as they can for a proper healthy diet.

It's pretty amazing the way God works, I never thought I would find myself in a place like this. I always envisioned myself working my way up in a kitchen and making extravagant food at a restaurant, and becoming the best chef I could be. But I know that is not where God wants me.
