

CATCH UP WITH KYLA




Merry Christmas Everyone!

We built a full system in six weeks, which was amazing as this is the first time we've done an Oasys training in Colorado. In the spring, we will try to grow other vegetables besides lettuce. So many people are hearing about what we are doing and getting excited about it and wanting to learn more that we quickly started another Oasys training in Costa Rica at the beginning of December. Team members have been working hard to get that system built quickly and have been amazing at finding all the parts needed in another country, as well as teaching others!



They are currently in South Africa, helping a family who is working on an Oasys system.

The family is just about ready to start selling the produce they've been growing and we have been praying that our DTS students will be a blessing to this family and to all of the people they will get to meet and tell about Jesus. While the DTS is there they are going to help set up for an Oasys training happening in January. The Director and his family will be leading the training and building another system, and training more people on our systems.

It has been really exciting to hear our director talk about all of the people who have been in contact with him. They want to learn more about what we are doing here so that they can bring food and jobs to people in many countries. As the new year is coming, so are many opportunities to share our knowledge and help people. We have 3-4 more training times scheduled across the globe and our director would like to allow all of us to go overseas to help with this while building more systems. God is doing amazing things here, and to be a part of this as a witness has been a huge blessing!
